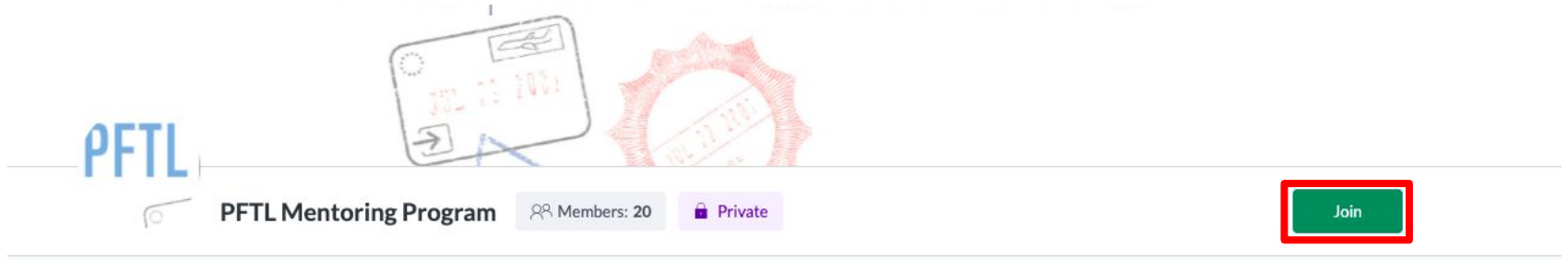
3. Once your account is approved, join the **PFTL Mentoring Program**
